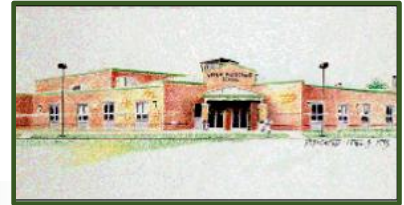

Extracurricular Activities

There are many opportunities for students to be involved in extracurricular activities and events at Upper Pittsgrove School. We encourage students to become involved in clubs, activities and events that match and/or expand a student's interest, skills and talents as it creates connections to school. Along with participation come expectations and responsibility. Participation in extracurricular activities is a privilege that all students deserve as long as attendance, behavioral and academic expectations are met.

Academic Requirement

Students who fail a course will be subject to athletic/extracurricular activity ineligibility. A student who fails to maintain academic requirements shall be ineligible to participate in activities for the marking period following the academic deficiency. Should the academic deficiency be the result of one (1) or more incomplete grade(s), activity participation shall be withheld pending the successful completion of the required subjects.

Attendance

Students are permitted to have two (2) unexcused absences from a practice of any school activity per marking period. There will be no unexcused absences from a game or a performance. It is the student's responsibility to bring doctor or parental notes to the advisor/coach of each activity within two (2) days of the absence. Failure to comply with this policy will result in dismissal from the program.

Code for Activities

The following will be considered violation of our conduct code for participants in activities which will result in immediate removal from the activity:

- Usage or possession of tobacco, alcohol or other drugs
- Vandalism to school property
- Theft
- Fighting on school property
- Disrespect of staff members
- Other such actions which will be determined by the Assistant Principal

Penalty (NO participation when suspended)

- First Offense: One (1) week suspension from squad/individual competition or the next extracurricular activity plus any consequences required by the discipline code.
- Second Offense: Two (2) week suspension from squad/individual competition or the next extracurricular activity plus any consequences required by the discipline code.
- Third Offense: Removal from the activity.
